# **SRI TRANG GLOVES (THAILAND)**



# ราคาหุ้นที่ตกไม่สมเหตุสมผล

## อะไรคือเหตผลที่เป็นไปได้ของราคาหันที่ตกเมื่อเร็ว ๆ นี้

หลังรายงานกำไรสุทธิ 2Q20 ที่ดีถึง 1.1พัน ลบ. ราคาหุ้นของ STGT ปรับตัวลดลงแรงถึงกว่า 10% เมื่อวานนี้ เราเชื่อว่าแรงขายดังกล่าวเกิดจากโอกาสที่อัตรากำไรจะลดลงจากดันทุน วัตถุดิบที่เพิ่มขึ้นและราคาขายเฉลี่ยที่ลดลงจากความต้องการที่ลดลงหลังมีวัคซีนสำหรับ COVID-19 เราเชื่อว่าความกังวลดังกล่าวมีมากเกินไป และคิดว่าราคาหุ้นที่ปรับตัวลดลงไม่ สมเหตุสมผลจากแนวโน้มการเติบโตของกำไรสุทธิรายไตรมาสที่ดีอย่างเห็นได้ชัดถึง 2x q-q ใน 3Q20E และต่อเนื่องไปใน 2021E จากราคาขายเฉลี่ยที่เพิ่มขึ้นและยอดคำสั่งซื้อถุงมือยางที่ ยาวถึง 4Q21-1H22

## ราคาขายเฉลี่ยที่เพิ่มขึ้น 2-3x จะมากกว่าตันทุนวัตถุดิบที่สูงขึ้น 10-30%

จากราคาขายเฉลี่ยที่ USD20.7 ต่อ 1,000 ชิ้น (ptp) ใน 2Q20 เราคาดว่าตัวเลขดังกล่าวจะเพิ่ม เป็น USD26ptp ใน 3Q20, USD35ptp ใน 4Q20 และ USD35-40ptp ใน 1H21 ก่อนชะลอตัว ลดลงเหลือ USD30-40ptp ใน 2H21 เราคาดว่าราคาขายเฉลี่ยที่เพิ่มขึ้น 2-3x ภายใน 12 เดือน จะมากกว่าต้นทุนวัตถุดิบที่สูงขึ้น 10-30% y-y สำหรับทั้งยางธรรมชาติและ Synthetic Nitrile Butadiene Rubber (NBR) ซึ่งเราคาดว่าจะเพิ่มใน 2H20-2021 จากอุปสงค์อุปทานตึงตัวหลัง ความต้องการยานยนต์กลับมา

## ความเสี่ยงด้านความต้องการและอัตรากำไรไม่ควรเกิดขึ้นก่อน 2022

เราเชื่อว่าหากมีวัคซีนใน 4Q20 – หรือ 1H21 ซึ่งมีความเป็นได้สูงกว่าตามที่เราคาดในกรณีฐาน ความต้องการถุงมือยางในตลาดโลกจะลดลง แต่ยังคงดีใน 2021 เนื่องจากประโยชน์ของถุงมือ ยางได้ขยายไปสู่อุตสาหกรรมที่ไม่ใช่การแพทย์อื่น ๆ อีกมากมาย นอกจากนี้จากข้อมูลของ ผู้บริหาร STGT ยังได้รับคำสั่งชื้อถุงมือล่วงหน้าไว้มากจนถึง 4Q21 สำหรับถุงมือยางธรรมชาติ และ 2Q22 สำหรับถุงมือยาง NBR โดยส่วนมากมีการตกลงราคาไว้แล้วในระดับสูงกว่า USD40ptp คิดเป็นอัตราการใช้กำลังการผลิต 88-90% ใน 2021 ตัวเลขดังกล่าวชี้ให้เห็นว่า กำไรสุทธิของ STGT ควรมีแนวโน้มที่ดีถึงกลาง 2020 หรือ 2H21 เป็นอย่างน้อยจากประมาณ การของเรา

## ช่องว่างระหว่าง Fundamentals และราคาหุ้นขยายตัวเพิ่มขึ้น


แม้ว่าจะคิดจากสมมติฐานราคาขายเฉลี่ยที่เพียง USD25.9/ptp สำหรับ 2020, USD30.1ptp สำหรับ 2021, และ USD26.5ptp สำหรับ 2022 ซึ่งต่ำกว่าราคาขายเฉลี่ยของ STGT ในปัจจุบัน ที่ USD40-60ptp อยู่มาก เราคิดว่า Valuation ของ STGT ยังน่าสนใจ โดยหุ้นมีการซื้อขายที่ FY21E P/E ที่เพียง 14.8x เทียบกับ Valuation ของคู่แข่งในประเทศมาเลเซียที่ 17-33x เรา เชื่อว่านักลงทุนกำลังมองข้ามความชัดเจนของอัตรากำไรและราคาขายเฉลี่ยของ STGT ซึ่ง ปัจจุบันเกิน 2020 และทิ้งห่าง USD20.7ptp ใน 2Q20
