กำไรที่แข็งแกร่งและมั่นคงยังไม่อยู่ในราคาหุ้น

ราคาหุ้นที่ปรับลงอย่างไม่สมเหตุผลเปิดโอกาสการลงทุน

เราเชื่อว่าราคาหุ้น STGT ที่ปรับลง 16% ในช่วงเวลาเพียง 2 วันนี้เป็นผลมาจากการที่นักลงทุน อ่อนไหวกับข่าวที่เกี่ยวกับวัคซีน พัฒนาการของวัคซีนเมื่อเร็ว ๆนี้ทำให้ราคาหุ้นของผู้ผลิตถุงมือ ยางทั้ง 5 รายใหญ่ของโลก ไม่ว่าจะเป็น STGT, Top Glove (TOPG MK), Hartalega Holdings (HART MK), Kossan Rubber Industries (KRI MK) และ Supermax Corp (SUCB MK) ปรับลงมากกว่า 20% ภายในเวลาไม่ถึง 4 วัน

กำไรสุทธิแข็งแกร่งอย่างชัดเจนใน 3Q20-2Q21

เราคาดว่า STGT จะมีกำไรสุทธิ 2พัน ลบ. ใน 3Q20 และ 3.8พัน ลบ. ใน 4Q20 ซึ่งจะทำให้ กำไรสุทธิทั้งปี 2020 เป็น 6.3พัน ลบ. เพิ่มขึ้นจากปี 2019 ที่ทำได้ 0.6พัน ลบ. เราคาดว่า โมเมนตัมการเติบโตของกำไรสุทธิของ STGT จะยังคงแข็งแกร่งในอีก 4 ไตรมาสข้างหน้าและมี แนวโน้มจะดีกว่าคาดการณ์ของ BBG consensus และเรายังเชื่อว่า STGT จะได้รับคำสั่งชื้อ ล่วงหน้ายาวไปจนถึงสิ้นปี 2021 ทั้งถุงมือยางธรรมชาติทั้งแบบมีแป้งและไม่มีแป้ง รวมถึงถุงมือ ยาง NBR ซึ่งมีสัดส่วน 37% ของยอดขายถุงมือยางของ STGT ในปี 2020-21

ราคาขายเฉลี่ยที่สูงขึ้นมากหักล้างการเพิ่มขึ้นของต้นทุนวัตถุดิบได้

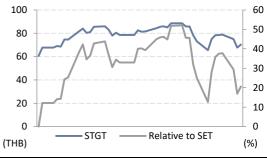
STGT ได้กำหนดราคาขายเฉลี่ยใน 3Q20 ไปแล้วที่ USD35 ต่อ 1,000 ชิ้น (ptp) และ USD40 ต่อ 1,000 ชิ้น (ptp) ใน 4Q20 ปัจจุบันบริษัทอยู่ระหว่างการตั้งนโยบายราคาขายใหม่สำหรับ ช่วง 1H21 ที่ราคา USD60 ต่อ 1,000 ชิ้น (ptp) สำหรับถุงมือยางไนไทร์ และ USD48 ต่อ 1,000 ชิ้น (ptp) สำหรับถุงมือยางธรรมชาติแบบไม่มีแป้ง และ USD42 ต่อ 1,000 ชิ้น (ptp) สำหรับถุงมือยางธรรมชาติแบบมีแป้ง และกำลังกำหนดให้ ราคา USD40 ต่อ 1,000 ชิ้น (ptp) ซึ่งเป็นราคาเฉลี่ยใน 4Q20 เป็นราคาขายต่ำสุดสำหรับถุงมือยางทั้ง 3 ประเภทใน 1H21 ทั้งนี้ เราปรับเพิ่มคาดการณ์ราคาน้ำยางธรรมชาติเข้มขัน (CL) ขึ้น 6-12% สำหรับปี 2020-21 และ ราคาน้ำยางสังเคราะห์ (SL) ขึ้น 12% สำหรับปี 2020 ตาม guidance ล่าสุดของผู้บริหาร

ปรับราคาเป้าหมายขึ้นเป็น 116 บาท ยังคงแนะนำซื้อ

เราปรับประมาณการ EPS growth ปี 2020-22 ขึ้น 47-68% บนสมมติฐานดังนี้ 1) ปรับเพิ่ม ราคาขายเฉลี่ยสำหรับปี 2020-22 ขึ้น 16.4-16.6% 2) ปรับเพิ่มราคา CL ขึ้น 6-12% ในปี 2020-21 และราคา SL ในปี 2020 ขึ้น 12% จากแนวโน้มอุปสงค์และอุปทานที่ตึงตัว และ 3) ปรับเพิ่มอัตราการใช้กำลังการผลิตปี 2020 ขึ้น 4% จาก 92% เป็น 96% เราปรับเพิ่มราคา เป้าหมายจาก 111 บทซึ่งอิง P/E FY21E ที่ 25x เป็น 116 บาท อิง P/E 17x FY21E สะท้อน ประมาณการ EPS ที่ปรับขึ้น เราคิดว่าสมมติฐาน P/E 17x FY21E มีความ conservative เพราะต่ำกว่า TOPG's และเท่ากับระดับก่อน COVID-19
