In coal, we trust

- กำไรสุทธิจะดีขึ้นใน 2Q-4Q22 จากปริมาณการผลิตที่สูงขึ้นของเหมืองถ่านหินใน อินโดนีเซีย ออสเตรเลีย และจีน
- ผลขาดทุนจากสัญญาป้องกันความเสี่ยงจากสัญญา Coal และ Shale Gas Swap อาจ ลดลงในปี 2022 จากปริมาณป้องกันความเสี่ยงที่ลดลงอย่างมีนัยสำคัญ
- คงแนะนำซื้อที่ราคาเป้าหมาย 18.8 บาท (SOTP)

กระแสการเติบโตเต็มกำลังรออยู่ข้างหน้า

เรายังมั่นใจในแนวโน้มการเติบโตของกำไรสุทธิของ Banpu และเชื่อว่าตลาดยังประเมิน ศักยภาพการเติบโตของกำไรของบริษัทฯ ใน 2Q22-2023 ไว้ต่ำเกินไป ประเด็นเก็บตกสำคัญ จากที่ประชุมนักวิเคราะห์หลังผลประกอบการ 1Q22 ประกอบด้วย 1) ผลขาดทุนสัญญาป้องกัน ความเสี่ยงจากสัญญา Coal และ Shale Gas Swap อาจลดลงในช่วงที่เหลือของปี 2022 จาก ปริมาณป้องกันความเสี่ยงที่ลดลงอย่างมีนัยสำคัญ; 2) กำไรสุทธิจะดีขึ้นใน 2Q-4Q22 จาก ปริมาณการผลิตที่สูงขึ้นของเหมืองถ่านหินในอินโดนีเซีย ออสเตรเลีย และจีน (IAC); 3) Upside จำนวนมากในด้านอัตรากำไรขั้นตันจากการขายถ่านหินใน IAC เมื่อพิจารณาจาก ปริมาณถ่านหินที่มีจำกัดพร้อมการตั้งราคาคงที่; และ 4) การจดทะเบียน BKV ซึ่งเป็นผู้ผลิต ก๊าซในชั้นหินดินดาน (Banpu และ Banpu Power (BPP TB, BUY) ถือหุ้นคนละครึ่ง) อาจ ปลดล็อคมลค่าที่ช่อนอย่ของธรกิจก๊าซในชั้นหินดินดานของ Banpu

Upside ของธุรกิจถ่านหินเพิ่มขึ้นจากทั้งปริมาณขายและอัตรากำไร

ในด้านธุรกิจถ่านหิน เราคาดว่า EBITDA จะโตในอัตราที่สูงขึ้นมากใน 2Q-4Q22 จาก 1) ราคา ขายเฉลี่ยที่สูงขึ้นของเหมืองถ่านหินใน IAC จากปริมาณถ่านหินที่เหลืออยู่เป็นจำนวนมาก ทั้งที่ ยังไม่ได้ตั้งราคาหรือตั้งราคาอิงกับค่าดัชนี โดยอยู่ที่ 69% ของปริมาณขายที่ 21mtpa ของ เหมืองในอินโดนีเซีย, 39% ของ 13mtpa ในออสเตรเลีย, และ 100% ของ 6mtpa ในจีน; 2) ปริมาณการผลิตที่สูงขึ้นเป็น 3.8mt (ทรงตัว q-q) ในอินโดนีเซีย, 2.6mt (เพิ่ม 1.6mt ใน 1Q22) ในออสเตรเลีย, และ 1.5mt ในจีน; 3) ผลขาดทุนสัญญาป้องกันความเสี่ยงที่ลดลงเหลือ USD10-15ล้าน จาก USD19ล้านใน 1Q22 จากปริมาณป้องกันความเสี่ยงที่เหลือเล็กน้อยที่ 0.35mt ในปี 2022 ที่ราคาป้องกันความเสี่ยงที่กว่า USD150/t

EBITDA ในธุรกิจก๊าซจากชั้นหินดินดานจะโตจากผลขาดทุนสัญญาป้องกันความ เสี่ยงที่ลดลง

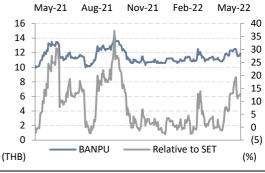
EBITDA ในธุรกิจก๊าซจากชั้นหินดินดานหลังหักผลขาดทุนสัญญาป้องกันความเสี่ยงน่าจะโต ต่อเนื่องใน 2Q22 จาก USD65ล้านใน 1Q22 โดยมีสมมติฐานจาก 1) อัตรากำไรขั้นตันที่สูงขึ้น ของก๊าซจากชั้นหินดินดานจากความต้องการที่สูงขึ้น; 2) ปริมาณการผลิตที่สูงขึ้น q-q; และ 3) ผลขาดทุนสัญญาป้องกันความเสี่ยงที่ลดลงจาก USD100ล้านใน 1Q22 เป็น USD60-70ล้านใน 2Q22 เนื่องจากปริมาณป้องกันความเสี่ยงที่ 70% ของการผลิตรายไตรมาส (ประมาณ 42bcf) จะถูกบันทึกในราคาป้องกันความเสี่ยงที่สูงขึ้นเป็น USD3.7-4.0/mmbtu

แนะนำซื้อจากกำไรสุทธิที่คาดว่าจะดีใน 2Q22 และปี 2022

เราคงแนะนำซื้อที่ราคาเป้าหมายที่ 18.8 บาท (SOTP) เราคิดว่าตลาดยังประเมินศักยภาพการ เติบโตของกำไรของ Banpu ใน 2Q-4Q22 ไว้ต่ำเกินไปดังจะเห็นได้จากประมาณการกำไรสุทธิ ปี 2022 ของเราที่ 28.7พัน ลบ. ซึ่งสงกว่าที่ตลาดคาดถึง 35%

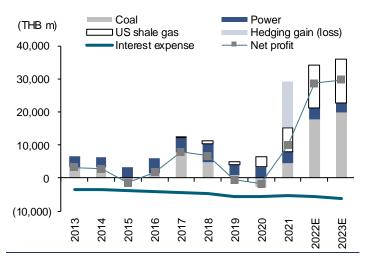
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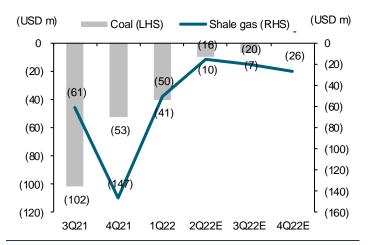

Exhibit 3: Estimated hedging losses for coal and shale gas



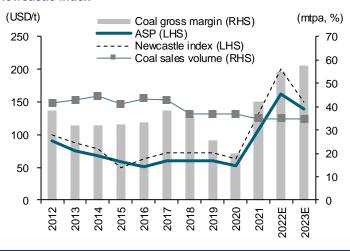

Exhibit 5: ICE Newcastle coal price index (May-22) (LQK22)



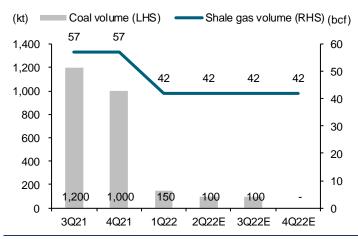

Exhibit 2: Coal gross margin, ASP, coal sales volume, Newcastle index



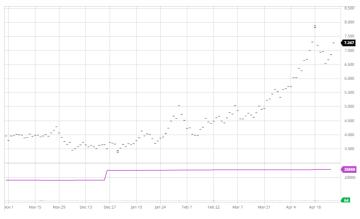
