การเยี่ยมชมสถานที่ยืนยันมุมมองเชิงบวก

- ในระหว่างการเยี่ยมชมสถานที่ในประเทศเกาหลีใต้ เราได้เห็นรากฐานที่แข็งแกร่งของ
 EGCO ผ่าน SK E&S ซึ่งเป็นพันธมิตรทางยุทธศาสตร์ของบริษัทฯ
- เราเชื่อว่าโรงผลิตไฟฟ้าจาก LNG Paju ขนาด 1.8GW ของ EGCO จะเป็นหนึ่งใน ปัจจัยหนนกำไรสำคัญตั้งแต่ปี 2022 เป็นตันไป
- คงแนะนำซื้อที่ราคาเป้าหมาย 245 บาท (SoTP)

การเยี่ยมชมสถานที่ในประเทศเกาหลีใต้ทำให้เห็นแนวโน้มเป็นบวกมากยิ่งขึ้น

ในระหว่างการเยี่ยมชมสถานที่ในประเทศเกาหลีใต้ เราได้เห็นรากฐานที่แข็งแกร่งของ EGCO ผ่าน South Korea Energy & Service (SK E&S) ซึ่งเป็นพันธมิตรทางยุทธศาสตร์ของบริษัทฯ บริษัทดังกล่าวเป็นผู้ให้บริการโซลูชั่นและพลังงานสะอาดระดับโลกในด้านพลังงานหมุนเวียน และไอโดรเจนสะอาดพร้อมธุรกิจ LNG ครบวงจร บัจจุบัน EGCO รับรู้ส่วนแบ่งกำไรผ่านหุ้น 49% ในโรงผลิตไฟฟ้าจาก LNG Paju (1.8GW, COD 2017) และโรงผลิตไฟฟ้าจากเซลล์ เชื้อเพลิง Gangdong (19.8MW, COD 2020) เราเชื่อว่าแนวโน้มราคาเนื้อกำซที่กำลังปรับขึ้น ในเกาหลีน่าจะเป็นประโยชน์ต่อ Paju เนื่องจากบริษัทดังกล่าวมีสัญญาซื้อ LNG ระยะยาวถึง 20 ปีในปริมาณ 1mtpa และราคาที่กำหนดมาตั้งแต่ปี 2017

โรงผลิตไฟฟ้าจาก LNG Paju เป็นปัจจัยหนนการเติบโตสำคัญของ EGCO

เราเชื่อว่าโรงผลิตไฟฟ้าจาก LNG Paju ขนาด 1.8GW ของ EGCO จะเป็นหนึ่งในปัจจัยหนุน กำไรสำคัญตั้งแต่ปี 2022 เป็นต้นไปโดยมีสมมติฐานจาก 1) ความสำคัญสูงของการส่งไฟฟ้าใน เกาหลีใต้ในฐานะที่เป็นโรงไฟฟ้าฐานจากการผลิตไฟฟ้าอันมีข้อได้เปรียบทางยุทธศาสตร์และ ต้นทุน; 2) Upside ในด้านอัตรากำไรสำหรับปริมาณนำเข้า LNG 1mtpa ตามสัญญาเทียบกับ ราคา LNG ในตลาดโลกที่คาดว่าจะสูงกว่าจากอุปทานที่ตึงตัวและความต้องการที่เพิ่มขึ้นจาก สหภาพยุโรปเพื่อทดแทนอุปทานก๊าซจากรัสเซีย โดยเราคาดว่าแค่ Upside ในด้านอัตรากำไร เพียงอย่างเดียวอาจให้ส่วนแบ่งกำไรต่อปีสูงถึง 0.5-1.0พัน ลบ. แก่ EGCO; และ 3) กำไรสุทธิ 1.0-1.5 ลบ. ต่อ MW ซึ่งให้ส่วนแบ่งกำไรจากการดำเนินงานเฉลี่ย 3 ปีที่ 1.2พัน ลบ. ต่อปี ในช่วงปี 2019-21

เซลล์เชื้อเพลิง: แพงแต่ต้องเลือก

หุ้น 49% ในโรงผลิตไฟฟ้าจากเซลล์เชื้อเพลิง Gangdong ขนาด 19.8MW ของ EGCO ที่ใช้ เทคโนโลยีของ Doosan ให้ส่วนแบ่งกำไรต่อปีที่ 56 ลบ. ในปี 2021 แก่บริษัทฯ ในสาระสำคัญ โรงผลิตไฟฟ้าจากเซลล์เชื้อเพลิงใช้ก๊าซธรรมชาติเป็นวัตถุดิบเพื่อผลิตไฟฟ้า น้ำร้อน และ ใบรับรองเครดิตการผลิตพลังงานหมุนเวียน (REC) ซึ่งเป็นอีกรูปแบบหนึ่งของเงินอุดหนุนจาก รัฐบาลได้ในสัดส่วนเท่า ๆ กัน อย่างไรก็ดีตันทุนของการลงทุนของเซลล์เชื้อเพลิงยังอยู่ใน ระดับสง เพราะฉะนั้นเทคโนโลยีดังกล่าวจึงยังไม่สามารถแข่งขันได้ถ้าไม่มี REC

มี Downside จำกัดในขณะที่ Upside กำลังเพิ่มขึ้น

เราคงแนะนำซื้อที่ราคาเป้าหมาย 245 บาท (SoTP) เราคิดว่า Downside สำหรับราคาหุ้นของ EGCO มีจำกัดจากกำไรที่มีความชัดเจนสูงของสินทรัพย์ในประเทศไทย ฟิลิปปินส์ และเกาหลี ใต้ อย่างไรก็ดีบริษัทฯ ยังมีความเสี่ยงในด้าน Downside จากผลขาดทุนอัตราแลกเปลี่ยนที่อาจ มีเป็นจำนวนมากจากค่าเงินบาทที่กำลังอ่อนตัวในช่วง 2H22




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
Exhibit 1: Major transactions and contract structures of Paju Exhibit 2: Korea's power generation capacity breakdown CC

Exhibit 3: Net profit (loss) before FX from Paju ES






Exhibit 4: Net profit (loss) before FX from Gangdong FC
