- ธุรกิจขนส่งทางเรือและเคมีภัณฑ์เพื่อการเกษตรเป็นตัวถ่วง
- คงประมาณการกำไรและราคาเป้าหมายที่ 9 บาท

กำไร 4Q22 ปรับตัวลดลงเร็วกว่าที่คาด

TTA รายงานกำไรปกติที่น่าผิดหวังโดยอยู่ที่ 358 ลบ. ใน 4Q22 (-75% q-q, -73% y-y) กำไร ดังกล่าวต่ำกว่าที่เราคาด 57% ส่วนมากจากอัตรากำไรขั้นตันที่ต่ำกว่าคาดและค่าใช้จ่ายการ ขายและบริหารที่สูงกว่าคาด อัตรากำไรขั้นตันรวมอยู่ที่ 23.2% ลดลงจาก 24.8% ใน 3Q22 และ 27.0% ใน 4Q21 ส่วนมากจากธุรกิจขนส่งทางเรือ ค่าใช้จ่ายการขายและบริหารเพิ่ม 66% q-q และ 137% y-y จาก Pizza Hut สาขาใหม่ 6 แห่งและตันทุนขนส่งที่สูงขึ้นในธุรกิจ เคมีภัณฑ์เพื่อการเกษตร

อัตราค่าระวางปรับตัวลดลงใน 4022

ใน 4Q22 รายได้อยู่ที่ 7.1พัน ลบ. (-12% q-q, -6% y-y) ส่วนมากมาจากธุรกิจขนส่งทางเรือ และเคมีภัณฑ์เพื่อการเกษตร ตัวเลขดังกล่าวใกล้เคียงกับ TCE rate และปริมาณส่งออกปุ๋ยที่ ลดลง รายได้จากธุรกิจขนส่งทางเรือลดลง 14% q-q และ 21% y-y ตาม TCE rate ซึ่งอยู่ที่ USD19,457 ต่อวันโดยเฉลี่ย (-16% q-q, -38% y-y) ค่าใช้จ่ายดำเนินงานเพิ่มจากค่าใช้จ่ายใน ด้านเทคนิคอันเกี่ยวเนื่องกับการซ่อมบำรุงที่สูงขึ้น ยอดขายในธุรกิจเคมีภัณฑ์เพื่อการเกษตร ลดลง 23% q-q และ 35% y-y จากการแข่งขันอย่างรุนแรงจากผู้ผลิตชาวจีนหลังรัฐบาลจีนออก ข้อจำกัดในการส่งคอกใน 2022

คงประมาณการกำไร

เราคงประมาณการของเราที่คาดว่ากำไรจะลดลง 18% y-y ในปี 2023 และเพิ่มขึ้น 1% y-y ในปี 2024 จากสมมติฐาน TCE rate ที่ USD18,543 ต่อวัน (-5% y-y) ในปี 2023 และเพิ่มขึ้นเพียง เล็กน้อยที่ 2.5% ในปี 2024 ค่า Baltic Supramax index ที่ปรับขึ้นในช่วง 2 อาทิตย์ที่ผ่านมา เกิดจากการยกเลิกมาตรการห้ามนำเข้าถ่านหินออสเตรเลียซึ่งอาจหมายถึงการนำเข้าของจีนที่ เพิ่มขึ้นและการเก็งกำไรมาตรการกระตุ้นธุรกิจอสังหาฯ ของจีนหลังมาตรการปิดเมืองอัน เข้มงวด จากตัวเลขการเติบโตของการค้าโลกที่ตกต่ำและปัญหาท่าเรือคับคั่งที่ลดลงซึ่งช่วยคืน ความสามารถในการรองรับสินค้า เราไม่เชื่อว่าค่าระวางจะฟื้นตัวกลับอย่างรวดเร็ว

คงแนะนำถือที่ราคาเป้าหมาย 9 บาท

เราคงราคาเป้าหมายที่ 9 บาท (6x ของค่า 2023E P/E) และคำแนะนำถือ ปัจจุบัน TTA มีการ ซื้อขายที่ 5.4x ของค่า 2023E P/E และ 0.5x ของค่า 2023E P/BV แม้ว่าการประเมินมูลค่าจะ อยู่ในระดับต่ำ หุ้นกลับขาดความน่าสนใจจากแนวโน้มกำไรขาลง





Exhibit 3: Market TCE rate vs Thoresen's TCE rate
