Key takeaways from analyst meeting

Highlights

- SJWD ประสบความสำเร็จในการขายหุ้นกู้ 2 ชุดมูลค่ารวม 4 พันล้านบาทปลายเดือน ก.ย. ที่ผ่านมา อัตราดอกเบี้ย 3.76% (อายุ 2 ปี) และ 4.35% (อายุ 3 ปี) อันดับเครดิตเรทติ้ง BBB+ แนวโน้ม Stable จาก Fitch Ratings เงินที่ได้นำมารองรับการขยายธุรกิจในอนาคต รวมถึง M&A และบางส่วนนำไปชำระคืนเงินกู้ที่มีตันทุนสูงซึ่งส่งผลให้ภาระดอกเบี้ยจ่าย ลดลงตั้งแต่ 4Q23
- ฐรกิจคลังสินค้ามีการขยายงานอย่างรวดเร็วโดย Alpha บางนา กม. 19 พื้นที่ 18,000 ตรม. ขายพื้นที่เต็มแล้วและเริ่มให้บริการตันเดือน ก.ย., Alpha รังสิต (พื้นที่ 56,314 ตรม.) เริ่ม ให้บริการปลายเดือน ก.ย., Alpha แหลมฉบัง (พื้นที่ 53,284 ตรม.) อยู่ระหว่างการก่อสร้าง คาดแล้วเสร็จเดือน ส.ค. 2024, การก่อสร้าง Datasafe (Document storage) เฟส 2, การ ก่อสร้างห้องเย็นของ SCG นิชิเร เฟส 3 เริ่มให้บริการปี 2025 รวมถึงคลังสินค้า Free zone ที่แหลมฉบัง (พื้นที่ 30,000 ตรม.) ก่อสร้างแล้วเสร็จปี 2024
- ธุรกิจ Self-storage มีการ rebranding เป็น 'MeSpace' ปัจจุบันมี 9 สาขา บริษัทตั้งเป้า ขยายเพิ่มอีก 10 สาขาในปี 2024 ทั้งนี้ ธุรกิจนี้เป็นธุรกิจน้องใหม่ยังมีสัดส่วนรายได้เพียง 0.3% ของรายได้รวมในงวด 9M23 แต่อัตรากำไรขั้นตันดีขึ้นเป็นลำดับจาก 19.0% ในปี 2021 เป็น 23.5% งวด 9M23

Outlook

- ธุรกิจ Automotive รับฝากและบริหารรถยนต์ที่เป็นพระเอกในปี 2023 รายได้งวด 9M23 ก้าวกระโดด +166% y-y เป็นหนึ่งในธุรกิจที่มีอัตรากำไรขั้นต้นสูง 40.0% ใน 4Q23 จะมี รถ BYD Seal เข้ามาใช้พื้นที่ของบริษัทอีกราวหมื่นคัน รวมถึงในปี 2024 ที่จะมีรถ EV เตรียมเข้าไทยอีกหลายค่าย
- ธุรกิจห้องเย็นที่ถูกกระทบจากการที่ลูกค้า Destocking ในช่วง 1H23 ปัจจุบันมีสินค้าปลา เข้ามาใช้พื้นที่ห้องเย็นเพิ่มขึ้นมาก ทำให้อัตรากำไรขั้นต้นเพิ่มขึ้นเป็น 40% ใน 3Q23 และ จะมีแนวโน้มดีต่อเนื่องใน 4Q23-2024
- ใน 4Q23 จะมีรายการพิเศษ (non-cash item) จากการประเมินมูลค่ายุติธรรมจากการซื้อ กิจการ SCGL ปัจจุบันยังไม่ทราบจำนวนขึ้นอยู่กับผู้ประเมิน
- เราคาดกำไรจากการดำเนินงานปกติ 4Q23 เป็นไตรมาสที่ดีที่สุดของปีนี้ คงประมาณการ กำไรปี 2023 ที่ 803 ล้านบาท (+50% y-y) และคาดกำไรปี 2024 +48% y-y เป็น 1,189 ล้านบาท ซึ่งเชื่อว่าไม่น่ายากเกินไป อย่างน้อยหากบวกกลับค่าใช้จ่ายพิเศษจากการรับ โอนกิจการ SCGL ในปีนี้ราว 180-190 ล้านบาท กำไรใกล้เคียง 1 พันล้านบาทอยู่แล้ว
- แนะนำซื้อ ราคาเป้าหมาย 21.50 บาท (DCF, WACC 8.4%, LTG 3%) ราคาหุ้นปรับลง 30% ตั้งแต่รวมกิจการ SCGL จนมี 2024P/E 20 เท่า -1SD ของค่าเฉลี่ย 5 ปีที่ผ่านมา ขณะที่กำไรยกฐานขึ้นและคาดโตเฉลี่ย 27% CAGR (2023-25) คิดเป็น PEG เพียง 0.74





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

Exhibit 6: Margins and core profit, yearly





Unless otherwise specified, these recommendations are set with a 12-month horizon. Thus, it is possible that future price volatility may cause a temporary mismatch between upside/downside for a stock based on market price and the formal recommendation.

* In most cases, the target price will equal the analyst's assessment of the current fair value of the stock. However, if the analyst doesn't think the market will reassess the stock over the specified time horizon due to a lack of events or catalysts, then the target price may differ from fair value. In most cases, therefore, our recommendation is an assessment of the mismatch between current market price and our assessment of current fair value.

Industry Recommendations

Overweight. The analyst expects the fundamental conditions of the sector to be positive over the next 12 months.

Neutral. The analyst expects the fundamental conditions of the sector to be maintained over the next 12 months.

Underweight. The analyst expects the fundamental conditions of the sector to be negative over the next 12 months.

Country (Strategy) Recommendations

Overweight (O). Over the next 12 months, the analyst expects the market to score positively on two or more of the criteria used to determine market recommendations: index returns relative to the regional benchmark, index sharpe ratio relative to the regional benchmark and index returns relative to the market cost of equity.

Neutral (N). Over the next 12 months, the analyst expects the market to score positively on one of the criteria used to determine market recommendations: index returns relative to the regional benchmark, index sharpe ratio relative to the regional benchmark and index returns relative to the market cost of equity.

Underweight (U). Over the next 12 months, the analyst does not expect the market to score positively on any of the criteria used to determine market recommendations: index returns relative to the regional benchmark, index sharpe ratio relative to the regional benchmark and index returns relative to the market cost of equity.
