Impressive growth performance should continue

Despite severe geopolitical risk and uncertainty from Covid-19, we see limited impacts on JMT's performance. We expect JMT's net profit to increase 68% y-y in 2022 and at a 45% three-year CAGR during 2022-24, supported by its efficient cash collection (CC). Even amid the economic slowdown and Covid-19 in 2021, JMT was able to deliver record high CC. Thus, we expect its 2022 CC to rise by 48% y-y. As for the two JVs with KBANK, JMT expects this deal to be done by 2Q22. Based on our conservative assumptions, we project both JVs to share a loss of THB12m in 2022 but make up for this by contributing THB71m and THB154m to JMT's green bottom line in 2023-24.

Looking at long-term valuation rather than short term

Some investors wonder about JMT's valuation. We recommend investors look at its longer-term valuation rather than the short term due to the nature of the AMC business. This means that when JMT buys NPLs, it gains the right to receive loan repayments from the debtors – potentially for the next several years. It is from this future income that JMT makes its profits. As a result, we think the value of JMT should be assessed by the future profits that the current business is able to generate. JMT trades at 40x 2022E P/E. Once the returns from its new NPL acquisitions are realised, its P/E could drop to only 28x 2023E P/E.

An industry favoured by regulators, with a higher NPL supply

The BoT recently announced the rules for banks and AMCs seeking to set up JVs to resolve NPLs. We think this should benefit AMCs as they can now expand their businesses at a faster pace from the NPL backlog and source funds from their partnered banks. Regarding the NPL supply, in 2021 the NPL sales from banks fell to a five-year low. In our talks with AMC management teams, they viewed that the NPL supply in 2022 should be higher than in 2021. Therefore, we reiterate our view that AMCs are the most attractive plays in the diversified financial sector.

Maintain as top pick with our higher TP of THB80, up from THB70

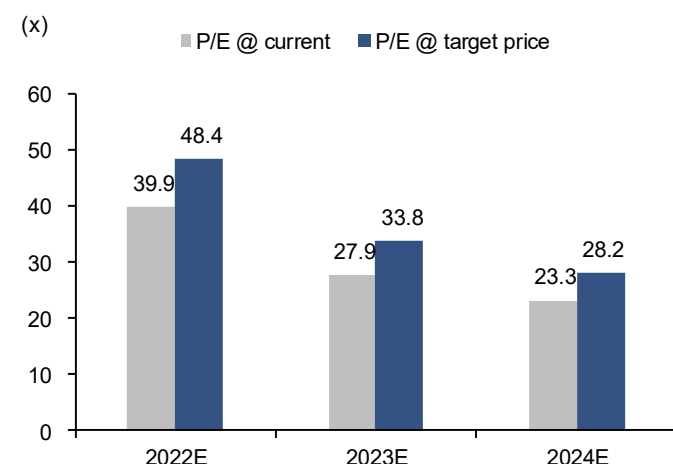
We revise up our TP to THB80, due mainly to our lower cost-of-equity assumption. We believe JMT is in a favourable sector. We see fewer regulatory risks for JMT compared with other financial companies. JMT remains our top pick, as we view it as a stock for hedging against the economic downturn based on its unsecured NPL portfolio, and also one that should grow with the economic recovery via its secured portfolio.

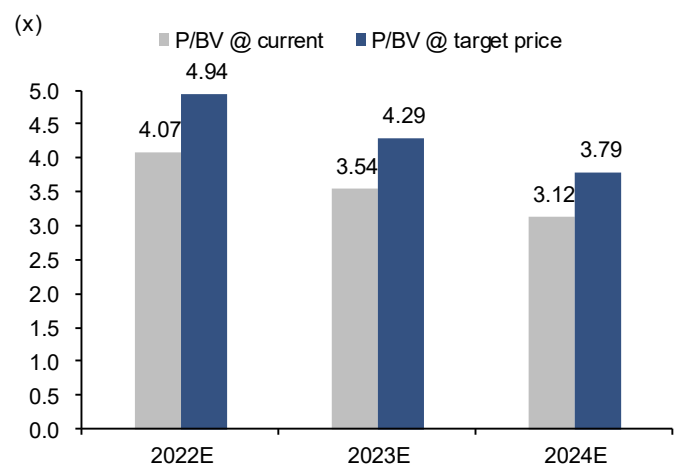

SINGER THAILAND (SINGER TB) - Ride the rising sun; Maintain BUY TP THB62.00

Records are there to break in 2022

After experiencing the highest net profit in the last 132 years at THB701m in 2021, we reiterate our view that SINGER should, again, deliver a record high net profit at THB1,244m (+78% y-y) in 2022, backed by the solid growth of its core businesses, including selling home appliances and lending, along with a slight contribution from its new business, solar rooftops. We are convinced SINGER will deliver strong performance in every quarter in 2022, and expect its net profit to increase y-y in every quarter. SINGER's 2022 EPS could increase at a slower rate than its net profit, we estimate at 14% y-y, due to the dilution from its RO.

Solar rooftops, a new long-term growth engine for SINGER

SINGER entered into the solar rooftop market by setting up a JV, named JGS, with GUNKUL and JMART. SINGER will be the main distributor and lender for clients who cannot afford to pay in cash. Thus, SINGER should see three benefits: 1) profits from selling solar rooftops; 2) interest income from lending, with an interest rate charge of c18%; and 3) profit sharing from its 9.9% holding in JGS. We are convinced that JGS and SINGER can successfully penetrate this market as SINGER already has a small commercial client base, c40,000-50,000 clients. Moreover, GUNKUL has experience in producing solar rooftops. We also expect an increase in solar rooftop demand. Although the profits from this project would be small compared with SINGER's net profits over 2022-24 (estimated at c1-3% of its earnings), we see it as an industry that is likely to grow in the future. This should help support its long-term growth.

The current businesses should continue to post robust growth

We expect both home appliance sales and auto title loans to continue to experience solid growth due to having different distribution channels, making SINGER stand out from its rivals. The new BNPL operators and truck title loan lenders should not be able to steal market share from SINGER. As a result, we expect its electrical appliance sales to rise by 25% y-y in 2022, with a stable gross profit margin at 47%. We project SINGER's loan growth in 2022 to be at 42% y-y, reaching THB15.5b, due mainly to an aggressive truck title loan expansion.

Top pick maintained with higher TP to THB62 from THB51

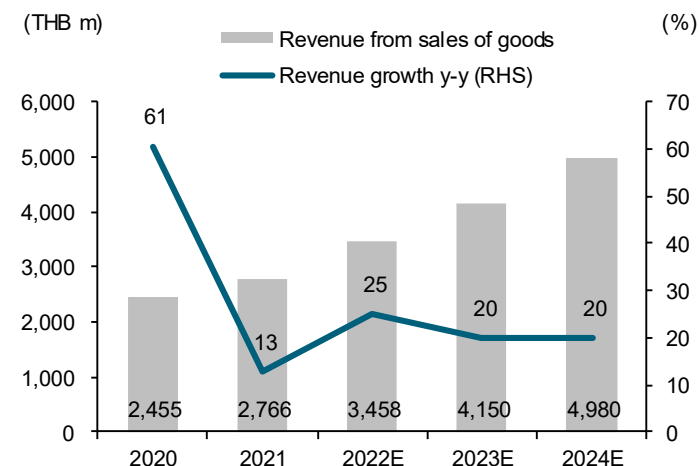
We revise up our 2022-23E net profit by 9%/11% to largely reflect our higher loan growth assumptions and raise our TP to THB62. We maintain SINGER as one of top picks as we believe it will deliver the highest net profit growth among our covered diversified financial stocks. Its premium valuation is justified by its sustained and robust growth, in our view.

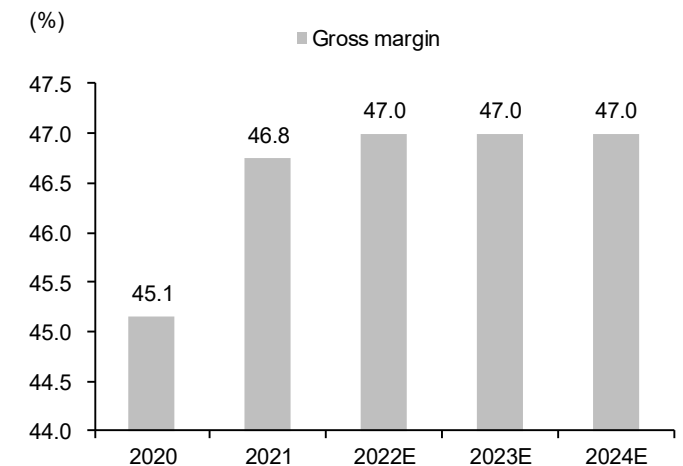

JAY MART (JMART TB) - A forest of new growth on the way; Maintain BUY TP THB62.00

JMART to launch over 20 more JVs/partnerships this year

JMART has announced plans to invest in over 20 joint venture (JV)s or partnership projects this year in diversified areas such as personal loans via human resources, restaurant chains, health and medical, and tech venture capital. The company targets at least one deal within 2Q22, while the rest should be finalised later this year. We like the company's new strategy, which we believe is like turning a group of random trees into a large, diversified forest ecosystem, where each tree supports the future growth of the ones nearby. More trees mean a bigger forest, and more growth via the power of synergy, in our view.

Solid growth from its existing expansion efforts

We are confident that JMART's growth potential will be realised in 2022. JMT and SINGER – the key contributors to JMART – are targeting growth in 2022 of 45% and 75%, respectively. Jay Mobile (JMB), KB J Capital, and Jas Asset (J TB, NR) are also projected to double their growth rates, according to management, while Coffee Shop and J Ventures should also see a solid improvement. Moreover, the new businesses that JMART has initiated recently include JayDee (JD), with a 25% investment, and JGS Synergy Power (JGS) (JV with GUNKUL and SINGER), which should start to contribute some profits to the company this year.

Earnings revisions

We factor in the earnings adjustments for JMT and SINGER. We also include the small earnings contributions expected from JD and JGS. Lastly, we upgrade our earnings estimates for JMB and KB J. As a result, we expect JMART's core profit in 2022 to reach an impressive THB1.98b (+79% y-y), which is an increase of 1% over our previous estimate.

Maintain BUY with our new TP of THB62

We retain our positive view on JMART. Key potential catalysts for JMART include: 1) growth in its new businesses such as JD and JGS; 2) solid growth in its current businesses; 3) the new investment potential that the company could gain from over 20 new projects this year; and 4) the power of its synergies, especially with BTS. Therefore, we maintain BUY on JMART with our new SoTP-TP of THB62, pegged to 44x 2022E P/E (+2SD of its mean). JMART remains our top pick in the ICT sector.

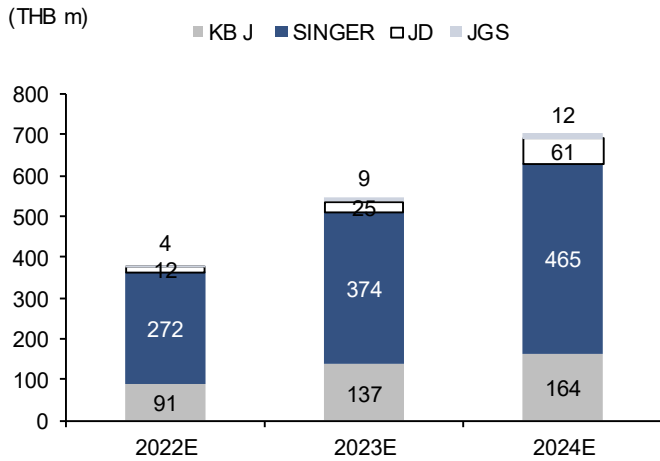

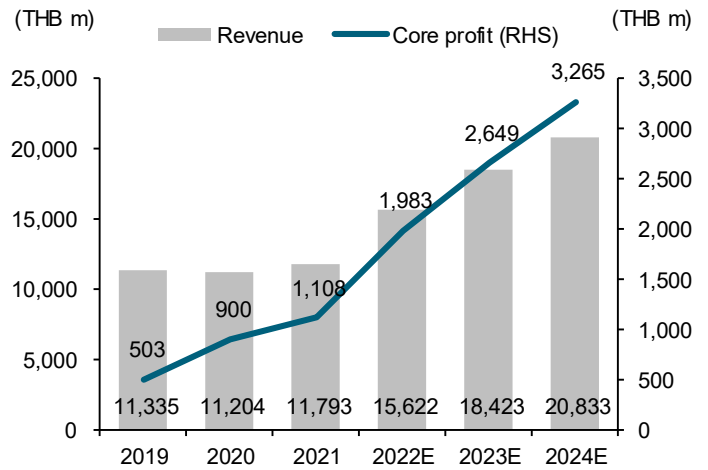

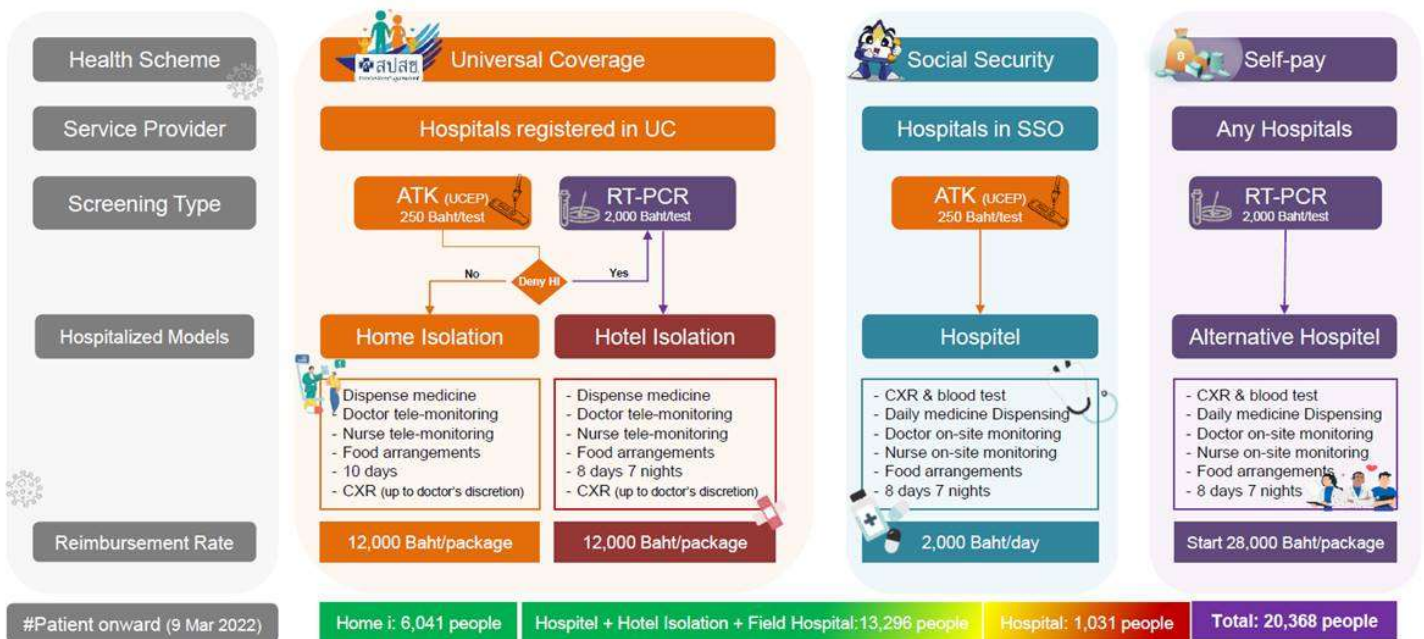

Key takeaways from Analyst Meeting

Bangkok Chain Hospital (BCH TB, BUY, THB28.5 TP) - Key takeaways from 4Q21 analyst meeting

Overall tone is positive.

- Covid related revenue should grow q-q. Number of Covid patients jump to c13,500 bed/day (12,500 beds for hospitel and 1,000 beds for hospitals) in Jan-Feb, higher than c3,700 bed/day (2,800 beds for hospitel and 900 beds for hospitals) in 4Q21 and c11,700 bed/day (10,200 beds for hospitel and 1,500 beds for hospitals) in 3Q21. Meanwhile RT-PCR test also increase to c3,700 case/day in Jan-Feb from c2,200 case/day in 4Q21.
- BCH should continue to capture Covid related revenue stream even in the new UCEP Plus scheme starting in from 16 Mar. Under the new scheme, green Covid patients are encouraged to enter Home Isolation program which BCH also joined the program and can reimburse up to THB12,000 per case. For green Covid patients under SSO scheme, patients still can have a treatment in hospitel and BCH can reimburse up to THB2,000 per day. Alternatively, BCH offer an alternative Hospitel package starting from THB28,000 per case for self-pay and insurance patients. Note that yellow and red Covid patients can undergo a free RT-PCR test and admitted in any hospitals under UCEP Plus. Thus, there is no impact on yellow and red patients.
- BCH maintain target revenue of THB17b in 2022 (vs THB9b in 2019 and THB21b in 2021) consisting of Covid related revenue of 9%, Moderna vaccination of 18% and non-Covid 72%. This implies that non-Covid revenue should jump by 38% from THB8.9b in 2021 to THB12.3b in 2022. Key driver are larger SSO registered members, renovation and expansion of its six hospitals and ramping up revenue from three new hospitals.
- BCH expect strong recovery of international patients in 2022. They plan to open the second foot Diabetic Center at KH Ramkhamhaeng (the flagship is at WMC) to attract more Middle East patients. Management also mention the potential to capture Saudi Arabia patients as BCH already offered their product to Saudi Arabia's government.
- Management mentioned that there is a chance that SSO may increase reimbursement rate this year given that the last increase was in 2020. SSO should factor in the treatment cost for Covid patient into both fixed payment (for green symptom) and high cost care (for yellow and red symptoms).

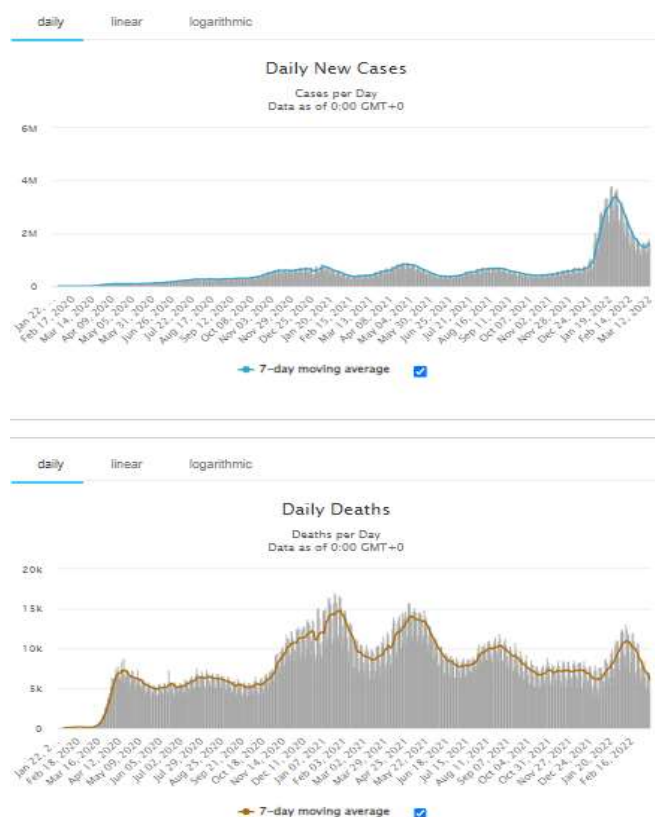

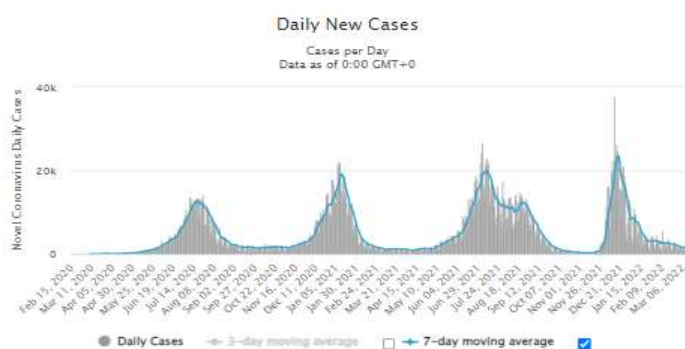

Exhibit 17: Global by new cases and deaths

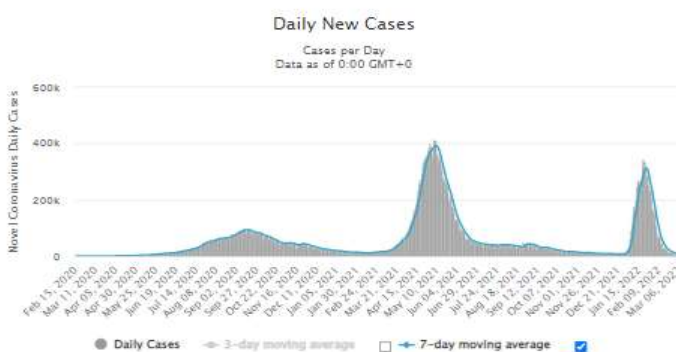

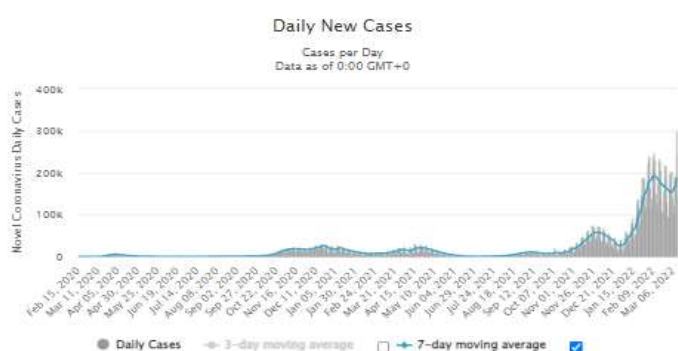
Daily New Cases in South Africa



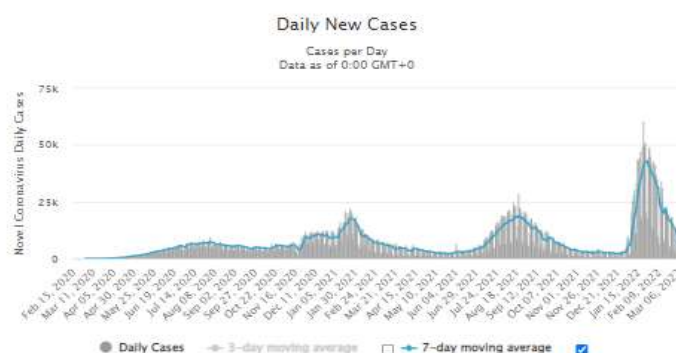
Daily New Cases in India



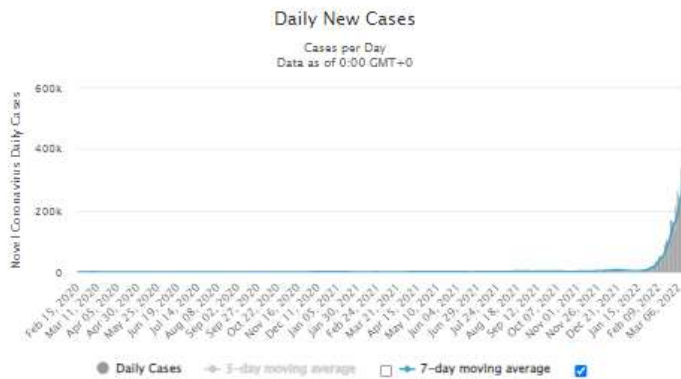
Daily New Cases in Germany



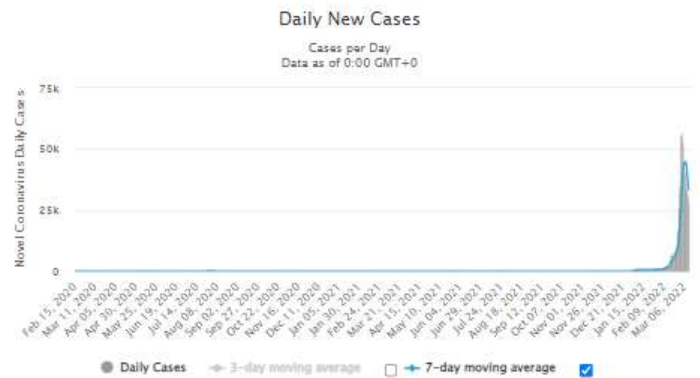
Daily New Cases in Mexico

Daily New Deaths in Thailand

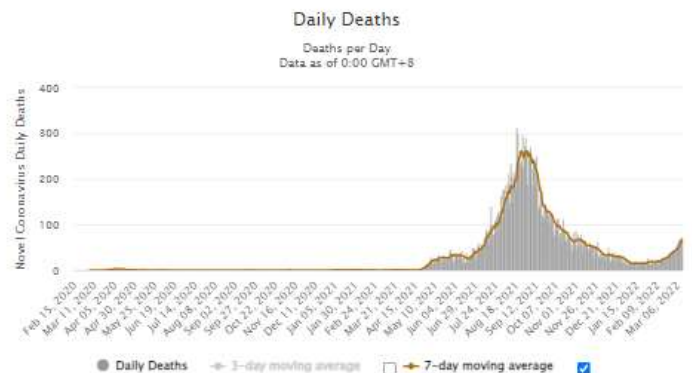

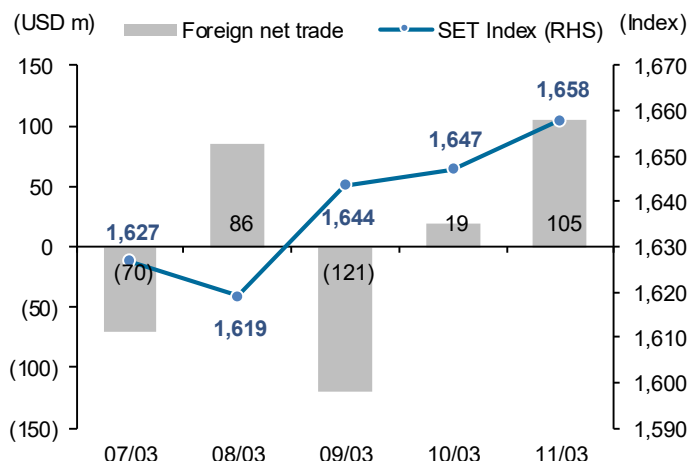

- **Fear over 'new bug strain', Doc points to spike in Hong Kong cases** BANGKOK POST: Health experts have sounded the alarm after the discovery of a new mutation of the Omicron coronavirus variant in Hong Kong. Hong Kong has been hit by its worst Covid-19 wave to date, recording the world's highest coronavirus death rate.
- **Feathering the nest egg, The Fiscal Policy Office wants to ensure formal workers have adequate retirement funds** BANGKOK POST: The Fiscal Policy Office (FPO) will continue to push for a national pension fund law to ensure employees in the formal system have sufficient savings for retirement, says director-general Pornchai Thiraveja. The cabinet approved in principle the national pension fund bill in March 2021 as proposed by the Finance Ministry. The bill is being scrutinised by the Council of State, then it is scheduled to be forwarded to parliament.
- **Perks for 7 EEC zones to be introduced soon** BANGKOK POST: Details of special incentives for seven economic zones in the government's flagship Eastern Economic Corridor (EEC) are scheduled to be announced over the next few days. Kanit Sangsubhan, secretary-general to the EEC Office, said interested investors will be allowed to apply immediately after the incentives are announced. According to Mr Kanit, the special incentives his office is going to offer to investment projects in the seven economic zones are similar to the Board of Investment's (BoI) privileges, but one major difference is the EEC Office will offer them to groups of companies or clusters of industries, while the BoI offers its incentives to individual companies. Under BoI law, the board is allowed to offer the highest privileges available in the country: a corporate income tax exemption for eight years, and a 50% reduction in the corporate income tax rate for five years once the tax holiday lapses if the applying projects invest in R&D or human resource development.

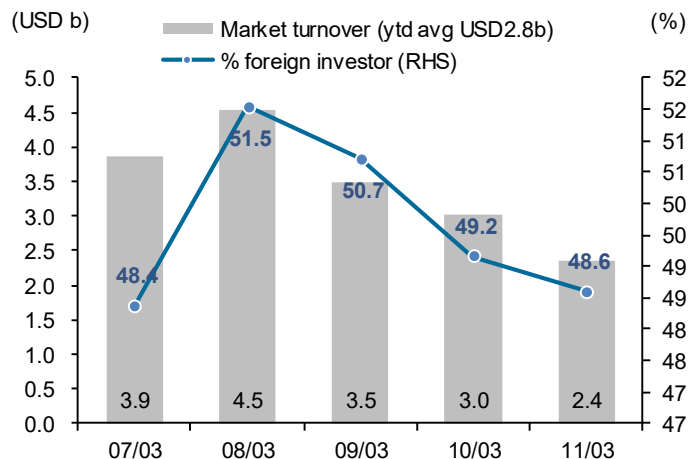
- **5G Expands to More-Affordable Phones as Chip Prices Fall** BANGKOK POST: Phone companies are more willing to upgrade the capability of phones in the \$200 range, market researchers say - 5G is increasingly available in cheaper phones, making faster mobile service affordable to more lower-income consumers around the world, market researchers say. The key to this broader access to 5G service is the falling price of the specialized semiconductors needed for 5G phones, a trend that analysts expect to continue over the next two years. The lower price makes it economically feasible to put the chips in a wider range of phones.
- **Newly opened Betong airport spurs high hopes for tourism** BANGKOK POST: Betong airport in Yala officially opens on Monday, raising hope it will revitalise tourism and the economy in the country's southernmost district. The airport received an operating licence from the Civil Aviation Authority of Thailand (CAAT) on Jan 28, said Transport Minister Saksayam Chidchob. It is the 29th airport to come under Department of Airports (DOA) supervision. The air link to Betong provides a safe and convenient alternative to road travel which cut through mountainous terrain, observers say. The 920-rai airport is capable of handling up to 300 passengers an hour or 800,000 a year, according to Mr Saksayam. Owned and operated by the DOA, the new airport is about 13 kilometres east of downtown Betong.
- **Nok Air preps more routes** BANGKOK POST: Nok Air is planning to operate more inter-provincial routes, starting with Nakhon Ratchasima-Chiang Mai, as well as resume international flights to Vietnam by mid-2022. Nok Air chief executive Wutthiphum Jurangkool said the airline is studying opportunities for cross-regional flights, particularly at the abandoned Nakhon Ratchasima airport and the new Betong airport in southern Yala province, to facilitate travel and create more economic activities. Without air transport, people have to spend five hours travelling from Hat Yai to Betong by road. People from the provinces without direct flights to their destination also have to wait for 2-3 hours for transit flights at Don Mueang airport.
- **Incentives entice two car makers, Goal to use country for BEV production** BANGKOK POST: A Japanese and a Chinese car manufacturer plan to invest in producing battery-powered pickups in Thailand later this year, says a Finance Ministry source who requested anonymity. The source said the government's recent announcement of tax incentives and a subsidy to promote the adoption of electric vehicles (EVs) in Thailand made the foreign car makers eager to use Thailand as a battery electric vehicle (BEV) production base, especially for pickups. Once the tax measures become effective, the excise tax for BEV pickups in Thailand will fall from various current rates to 0% this year until 2025, before rising to 2% in 2026. Buyers of BEV pickups priced 2 million baht or less are entitled to a state subsidy of 150,000 baht.
- **Tesla Set the Model for Selling EVs That Others Want to Follow** BANGKOK POST: Traditional car companies desire more online orders and fixed pricing, while dealers see a threat to their role - As car companies go electric, some are trying to wrest control from dealers on how those vehicles will be priced and sold, aiming to make the experience closer to the direct-selling model used by Tesla Inc. Ford Motor Co. executives recently outlined plans for a system in which dealers wouldn't stock any EVs on their lots, but rather customers would place factory orders at a no-haggle price. The dealership is still involved but mostly to deliver the vehicle. General Motors Co. is requiring its GMC-brand dealers to follow similar guidelines to sell the recently introduced Hummer electric pickup truck. The agreement stipulates that the dealers will be shipped only Hummers ordered by customers through GMC's website, a GM spokeswoman said. Carlos Tavares, chief executive of Jeep maker Stellantis NV, said the company is working in Europe on a new retail model for EVs that he described as a "direct-sales approach," which still would involve dealers. It is a dual effort that aims to improve customer service -- which he said lags behind other industries -- and defray the auto maker's high costs associated with moving to EVs, which require pricey lithium-ion batteries. Volkswagen AG has been relying solely on online customer orders for its recently launched ID.4 electric sport-utility vehicle, rather than shipping them to stock dealer lots, said VW U.S. sales chief Ray Mikiciuk. Plug-in vehicles today account for only about 4% of overall U.S. sales. But changes to the retail model for electrics are significant for dealers because EVs are expected to rapidly become a bigger slice of their sales in coming years.
