Economic news

Govt girds for China visit influx, Travellers' return 'likely to be gradual' BANGKOK POST: Transport Minister Saksayam Chidchob said on Wednesday he and Tourism and Sports Minister Phiphat Ratchakitprakarn were invited to attend a Jan 5 meeting with the Public Health Ministry at Government House to prepare for the return of Chinese tourists. Mr Saksayam said the Ministry of Public Health is also coordinating with the Chinese embassy for details about China's reopening to help prepare travel measures. Throughout next year the number of Chinese travellers using AoT-operated airports is expected to be around 7-10 million, compared with the pre-Covid number of 20.5 million.

- Russians flock to Thailand as tourism rebounds from collapse Russian visitors, with data showing monthly arrivals doubling in November and up nearly seven times than September, far outpacing rises from other countries in the run-up to peak travel season. The country is seeing a much-needed tourism boom, with 1.75 million visitors in November, quadruple the number received for the whole of last year when flights and foreign arrivals were limited by the pandemic.
- Reopening propels fuel consumption BANGKOK POST: The full reopening of the country from July drove up fuel consumption, which grew by 14% year-on-year in the first 11 months of 2022, the Department of Energy Business reported on Wednesday. From January to November, consumption of fuels diesel, petrol and gasohol, jet fuel, fuel oil, liquefied petroleum gas (LPG), kerosene and compressed natural gas stood at 150 million litres per day (MLD). Jet fuel consumption saw the highest growth of 90% to 8.7 MLD, up from 4.7 MLD in the same period last year, said department chief Nanthika Thangsupanich. She attributed the big increase to the easing of restrictions on air travel, previously imposed to contain the spread of Covid-19.
- Hong Kong's travel sector struggling with shortage of staff, coaches BANGKOK POST: Hong Kong's tourism sector has struggled to secure more manpower and coaches ahead of a proposed full reopening of the mainland Chinese border next month and needs government subsidies to recover from almost three years of Covid-19 travel curbs, industry leaders have said. Ricky Tse Kam-ting, founding president of the Hong Kong Inbound Tour Operators Association, on Monday said his own business before the pandemic had focused on trips for Southeast Asian tourists and maintained more than 100 employees. Now the travel agency had fewer than 10 members of staff, including several coach drivers, he added.
- Govt to sell up to B297bn of bonds in January-March BANGKOK POST: The governments plans to sell up to 297 billion baht of government bonds in the January-March quarter to restructure and manage debt, the finance ministry said on Wednesday. The bonds will be sold domestically, it said in a statement.
- China's Covid surge leads countries to adopt entry restrictions
 BANGKOK POST: Nations across the globe are implementing or considering measures to test or restrict travellers from China as the country of 1.4 billion abandons its Covid Zero policy and prepares to reopen borders in early January.

Southwest Airlines faces storm of criticism over holiday chaos BANGKOK POST: NEW YORK - More than 10,000 flights cancelled over the Christmas holiday, chaos at airports across America: Southwest Airlines found itself in the hot seat Tuesday as the airline behind the lion's share of the weather-linked travel mayhem. The Dallas-based, domestic-focused carrier, which has historically enjoyed a strong reputation with consumers, drew withering expletive-filled rebukes on social media, where labor leaders also highlighted horror stories from stranded airline employees.

Exhibit 1: Foreign fund flow and SET Index




Exhibit 2: Foreign participation
